

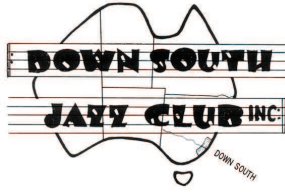

On 23rd April the Down South Jazz Club is delighted to be able to bring back to the stage of Club Sapphire after a period of four years, that wonderful vocalist from Canberra, Angela Lount, with “An Intimate Evening with Angela & Leo” featuring Angela Lount on vocals and Leo Joseph on piano.

Vocalist Angela Lount from Canberra has brought her band to the Down South Jazz Club on many occasions over the years. Her last appearance was a wonderful duo in January 2022 with Wayne Kelly on keyboard. On this occasion she brings her soulful, bluesy voice for another intimate evening, this time with Canberra piano legend, Leo Joseph. A very popular and entertaining vocalist, she is able to entice you onto the dance floor and has a great understanding of what a performance needs to get everyone going. She was a member of the Woden Valley Youth Choir for five years and has toured Australia, New Zealand, Europe and the UK with them. She later became a member of the Darkside Divas, an all female group.

Originally from Adelaide, Leo Joseph has been playing piano for more than 50 years. He lived and played in Brisbane for four years and then in Philadelphia for 8 years before he moved to Canberra in 2005. He quickly became a part of the Canberra jazz and blues communities where, as he likes to say, he is at home in that wonderful grey area that straddles the purer forms of both genres. For some 15 years now, Leo has been accompanying Angela Lount on piano as well as in bigger line-ups such as Key Grip. Leo’s philosophy when accompanying Angela anywhere on that spectrum from jazz standards to American songbook tunes or blues-infused jazz tunes, is to let Angela’s voice fly!

This excellent evening of jazz will cost \$20 for jazz club members and \$25 for visitors with music commencing at 7.30 pm (doors open at 7 pm).
