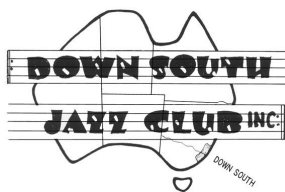

On Thursday 20th August The Down South Jazz Club will be bringing members and visitors a special treat at Club Sapphire with a return of The Telepathetics, and also featuring once again The Sapphire Coast Anglican College (SCAC) Jazz Band

By and large, The Telepathetics (Clare and Steve Fitzgerald, piano and percussion) have arranged themselves in an old musical fashion since their inception 13 years ago. Stretching themselves like butter over too much bread, across a range of instrumental and stylistic disciplines, they have performed on stages in Canberra and the Far South Coast alongside friends and acquaintances such as Stuart King, Tate Sheridan, Elle Osborne, Sam McNair and CJ Shaw to name a few. On this occasion they will be joined by Julian Gonzalez (bass), Nick Keeling (trombone) and Jason Dempsey (flute) to perform music of Claude Bolling and Frank Zappa.

The SCAC Jazz Band are in their fourth year of music-making. Under the direction of Julian Gonzalez and Steve Fitzgerald they have performed multiple times at the Merimbula Jazz Festival, Four Winds' Spring Youth Music Festival and at a range of school functions. Their repertoire includes big band standards and video game and film soundtracks, and their thirst for Friday morning rehearsals remains unquenched.

This entertaining evening of jazz will cost \$20 for jazz club members and \$25 for visitors with music commencing at 7.30 pm (doors open at 7 pm).
